**1.** Click on *Log in*



**2.** Enter your details and click Log In:

- Your username is your student ID number
- Your password is password (do not check *Remember Me*)

**4.** On your profile page, scroll all the way down to the bottom and create a new password. Use the same password you use to log in at ISB. You will need to type it twice. Click update when you're finished

**5.** On the same Profile page, check for the e-mail box (write down your e-mail address for later) and copy the first part of your e-mail address (the part before the @ sign).



**6.** Click *ISB Blogs ← Visit Site* at the top left corner of your screen.

**7.** Click on *Create a new blog*

- Give your blog a title (this can be changed later) and choose if you would like it listed in public searches.
